- ✚ You must be enrolled in at least one theatre or communications class per semester.
- ✚ You must maintain a 3.00 G.P.A.
- ✚ You must be a good college citizen.

Eligibility to apply

- ✚ You must be admitted to St. Andrews.
- ✚ You must have paid your \$250 deposit to Admissions at St. Andrews.
- ✚ You must file a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) form or submit a letter indicating you have no financial need. The FAFSA is available in all high school guidance offices or you may file online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. The St. Andrews code is 001540.
