



# Therapeutic Horsemanship Scholarship Requirements

## Scholarship Requirements

Student must have demonstrated academic excellence

- Applying student must have an overall G.P.A. of 3.0 or above
- Two letters of reference
  - One from a non-related teacher or guidance counselor
  - One from your riding instructor or the director of the therapeutic program where you have volunteered
- Applying student must have documentation of having volunteered at least 50 hours at a PATH Intl. (formerly NARHA) Therapeutic Horsemanship Center **OR**
- Write a one page paper about a visit you have had to a PATH Intl. Therapeutic Horsemanship Center **OR**
- Visit the PATH Intl. website ([www.pathintl.org](http://www.pathintl.org)) and research three Therapeutic Horsemanship Centers and write a one page paper about the benefits of each center as presented by their websites

## Eligibility

- You must be admitted to St. Andrews Presbyterian College
- You must have paid the \$250 Enrollment Deposit to Admissions at St. Andrews
- You must file a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) form or submit a letter indicating that you have no financial need. The FAFSA form is available online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). The St. Andrews school code is **001540**.
