

**TUITION POLICY
LAURINBURG AND SANDHILLS CAMPUSE
Adopted 2002**

Important Note: The programs of study offered at the Laurinburg and Sandhills campuses are designed to meet the needs of different learning constituencies. Tuition rates reflect the different character of each campus as well as the relative cost of operation [including the different levels of student services and facilities maintenance]. Students enrolled either at the Laurinburg or the Sandhills campuses are expected to follow the program of study available at the campus where they are enrolled. Because of the differing tuition structure, which reflects the differing costs of operation, certain restrictions are placed on the ability of students to take courses at a campus other than the one at which they are officially enrolled. Restrictions are also placed on the frequency with which students may change their official enrollment status from one campus to the other.

The lower tuition rate at the Sandhills campus reflects the non-residential, essentially part-time character of an evening and weekend academic program which uses the physical facilities of another institution, and is designed primarily for students who are older or who are working full-time while completing an undergraduate degree. Students enrolled at the Sandhills campus who wish to accelerate a degree program should consider transferring enrollment to the Laurinburg campus.

Students Enrolled at the Laurinburg Campus:

- 1) A student enrolled at the Laurinburg campus may request permission to take a course or courses at the Sandhills campus. During the regular September to May academic year, students enrolled at the Laurinburg campus who receive permission to take a course at the Sandhills campus will pay the tuition rate that applies to the Laurinburg campus. Normally a maximum of one course per academic year may be approved.
- 2) During the summer, students enrolled at the Laurinburg campus who receive permission to take a course or courses exclusively at the Sandhills campus pay the Sandhills tuition rate.

Students Enrolled at the Sandhills Campus:

- 1) A student enrolled at the Sandhills campus may request permission to take courses offered at the Laurinburg campus. Sandhills students may take courses at the Laurinburg campus only if the course is not taught on the Sandhills campus that semester. The student registers on the Sandhills campus and pays Sandhills tuition.

Permission

Permission to take a course or courses at a campus other than the one where a student is officially enrolled is requested from the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs.
