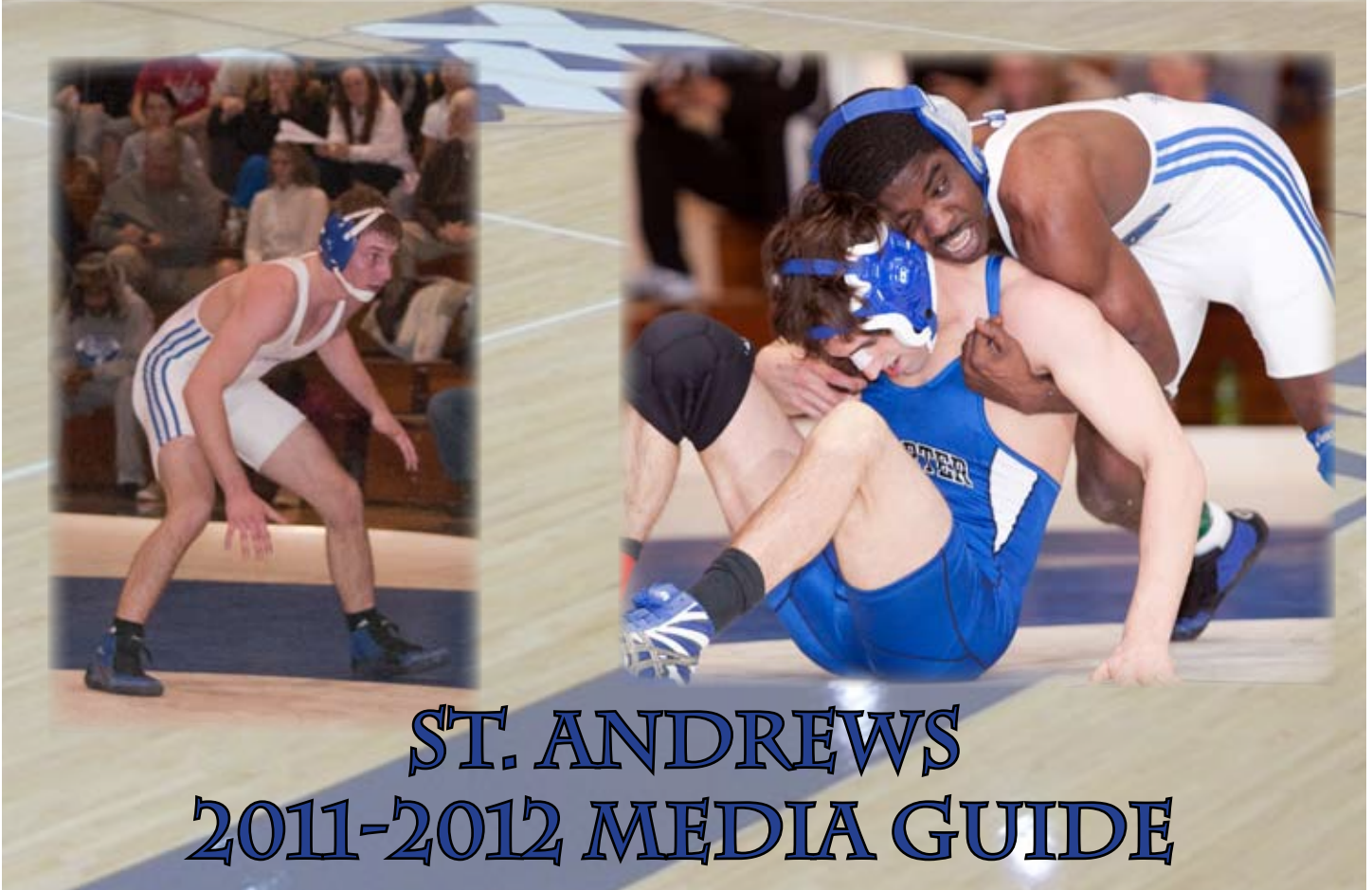

COACH'S BIOGRAPHY

JOE BARANIK

Joe Baranik enters his sixth season as the Knights wrestling coach after being named the inaugural head coach of the newly established St. Andrews wrestling program in March of 2006.

In his first two seasons as the St. Andrews head coach, Baranik guided the Knights to several NCAA Division II milestones. The Baranik coached Knights defeated Anderson University in December of 2007 for the program's first-ever D-II victory. Baranik also coached the teams first-ever regionally ranked wrestler, a 24-match winner, and the program's first-ever grappler to place in the East Regional.

Baranik joined the SAPC athletic department after spending 2 1/2 years at Maury High School (Norfolk, Va.) where he worked in the Department of Health and Physical Education. Baranik has also served as the head wrestling coach at Maury. Baranik has qualified 13-of-14 Commodore wrestlers for Regionals, coached two District Team Championships, and coached 14 District Champions in that short time period.



Baranik brings a wealth of knowledge and experience to the mat having worked as an assistant at four Division-I colleges and coaching at the high school level for 16 years; acquiring over 24 years of experience all together.

Baranik started his coaching as an assistant at Slippery Rock University. Over the past 24 years, he has also coached at the University of Virginia, the U.S. Military Academy, and Old Dominion University.

Baranik's experience at West Point and UVA has also helped prepare himself for coaching at SAPC.

Baranik's high school coaching experience has consisted of working at Mercer High School (Mercer, Pa.), Hollidaysburg Area High School (Hollidaysburg, Pa.), and Maury. Baranik has coached a Pennsylvania State Champion, two State finalists, and has had a fifth-place team in the PIAA State Tournament.

The resume of Joe Baranik also consists of numerous other coaching experiences and accomplishments including camps, clubs and clinics. Baranik has worked with the National Wrestling Coaches Association (NWCA), the Pennsylvania Wrestling Coaches Association (PWCA), and the PA Wrestling Newsmagazine.

Baranik resides in Laurinburg with his wife, Roberta, and two children, Troy & Marina.

LET'S HIT THE MATS

The St. Andrews University Wrestling Team has been gearing up for the start of the 2011-12 season as they travel to Belmont Abbey for their first match on Friday, November 4th. The Knights have been running, strength training, jumping rope, and swimming as forms of cross-training along with their improving their wrestling techniques on the mats.



With eight new freshmen from five different states to go along with four seniors, four juniors, and five sophomores, head coach Joe Baranik looks to put his best 10-man team on the mats since the program was established in 2006. Leading the way will be

junior Richard Manwarren (174 lbs.), who won 27 matches last year and placed 5th in the Super Region II national qualifier. The top four at the Super Regions qualify for the NCAA National Championships.

Senior Eric Brown (125) looks to have a good year as well as he placed 7th in the Super Region II tournament last year and 5th his freshman year. Brown has defeated three All-Americans in his career thus far. Brown will be pushed by junior Josh Tegard. Laurinburg native Casey Gashaw (133), who was a red-shirt last year, enters his senior season with a good shot at making nationals. Gashaw has started for three years and has beaten several nationally ranked wrestlers. He will be pushed by freshman Matt Craven.

“The attitude has been super this year,” stated Coach Baranik. “The upper classmen are taking the freshmen under their wings and everyone on the team is helping each other get better. We have great leadership from Brown, Manwarren, and Greg Pattis.”

Other returning wrestlers looking to make an impact this year are senior Greg Pattis (197), junior Sterling Perry (141) and red-shirt freshman Steffan Baker (165). Senior Josh Price will fight for the starting position at 197, while junior Patrick Wells will push Perry for the 141 lb. slot. Freshman Mykwan Roebuck of Savannah, GA, will also grapple for a spot at 165 lbs.

Freshmen who look to make the varsity include Kody Getkin (149), from Danville, PA, along with Luke Gregory (157) from Greensboro, NC, and Trent Harris (184) from Pittsboro, NC. Sophomore Caleb Mitcler will battle Getkin for the starting spot at 149 lbs., while sophomore James Green will fight for the nod at 157 lbs. and sophomore Kevin Hall will grapple for the varsity spot at 184 lbs.



At the 285 lb. weight class, two freshmen will wrestle off for the starting position. It will either be Danny Iovino-Ortiz from Milford, CT, or Denny Vaughan, from Richmond, VA.

“‘Student Coach’ Justin Hoover has been a real asset to us this year,” added Baranik. “If I was in a battle, I would want him on my side. He is a born leader and I am sure his help will go a long way for a successful season this year.”
