

## **Student Access to Day, Evening, and Online Classes**

Traditional, residential students will normally complete their courses on the main campus. Should the need arise for main campus students to access online or off-site courses through the Center for Adult and Professional Studies, the student, in consultation with her/his advisor will contact the Associate Dean for Adult and Extended Programs to investigate alternative course deliveries. Tuition and fees will be consistent with tuition and fees on main campus. Courses taken online will also incur a charge of \$150 per course. Any overload charges generated by these alternative arrangements will be borne by the student. Students admitted to St. Andrews through the main campus must wait at least two semesters after their last main campus enrollment to be considered for admission into the Center for Adult and Professional Studies. Summer online courses offered through the Center for Adult and Professional Studies will be available to all students, regardless of campus affiliation. Tuition and fees for summer courses are in accordance with the fee schedule published in the current catalog.
