

Campus Safety and Security

The Office of Campus Safety and Security, located in Burris Hall, provides leadership for developing and implementing safety and security measures for the entire St. Andrews community. Activities include, but are not limited to, vehicle registration, guest registration, traffic regulations enforcement, patrol of College property and facilities, first-line response for situations involving students, staff, and faculty safety, fire safety, hazardous weather alerts and implementation of emergency text messaging and voice mail communications, crisis intervention, and prevention programs. The Office also maintains close communication with Laurinburg and Scotland County law enforcement. Working within a framework of federal, state, and local laws, Campus Safety and Security also maintains compliance with the institutional policies and educational philosophy of St. Andrews.
